DEADLINES AND SUBMISSION SCHEDULE

Due to the volume of submissions, abstract reviews and notifications will follow the schedule below.

February 28, 2019

February 28, 2019

Invited speaker submission deadline

March 4, 2019

Abstract reviews and selection begin

April 15, 2019

Notification of accepted authors begins

September 1, 2019

Poster submission deadline

August 1, 2019

All presenters must be registered to appear in the Program Book.

September 15, 2019

Oral and poster presenters must be registered for the Congress to avoid cancellation of the presentation.

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Interest Area

Volunteer authors—Identify the interest area that most aligns with your content.

Invited speakers—Select the correct primary topic and identify the session chair to assure proper assignment.

Provide the following information for each author:

Name – First, Middle Initial, Last

Organization/Affiliation

Country

VALID email address for each author

Abstract Title and Body

Title:	Clearly identify the focus of the abstract in 15 words or less.
Abstract body:	250 words or less
Abstract preference:	Oral or Poster <i>Session chairs may suggest a change in presentation type.</i>
Abstract language:	Submit in English, Spanish, or Portuguese. Abstracts will not be translated, they will be distributed in the language(s) as submitted.
Abstract structure:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Objective/Hypothesis▪ Methods Used▪ Results▪ Conclusions
Language:	Will your talk or poster be given in English, Spanish, or Portuguese?
Optional presentation:	Volunteer submissions – option to convert to a poster if not selected for a talk. <i>Reviewers will not see the question or your response.</i>
<u>Do not</u> include:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Images▪ Tables▪ Commercial content (<i>i.e. trade names or trademarked products</i>)
Content:	Abstracts AND presentations must be of an educational nature and may not be used to promote products/services.
Before you press the submit button:	<u>Carefully proofread</u> and check your submission for accuracy. Abstracts will be distributed as submitted.
Email confirmation(s):	An automated email confirmation will be sent when the completed abstract has been submitted.

If your abstract does not comply with these requirements, you will be asked to adjust the text before a final decision can be made by the Session Chairs.

ABSTRACT REVIEWS

Abstracts received by February 28, 2019 will be released to the session chairs for review on March 4, 2019.

Abstracts will be evaluated separately using the following criteria:

- Relevance to session topic
- Creativity and originality of content
- Tangible message, solutions, and best practice(s)

Session Chairs reserve the right to refuse a presentation based on, but not limited to, the following criteria:

- A lack of scientific content or merit
- Commercial content (*i.e. trade names, trademarked products, etc.*)
- Subject matter not aligned with the focus of a session

REGISTRATION FEES AND TRAVEL EXPENSES

When an abstract is accepted, the presenting author is required to attend the meeting to present, must register for the Congress, and pay the registration fee. Each presenter is also responsible for his/her travel and accommodation expenses, unless written confirmation of funding assistance is provided by the inviting Session Chair.

All presenters must be registered by August 1, to appear in the Program Book.

Oral and poster presenters must be registered for the Congress by September 15 to avoid cancellation of the presentation.
